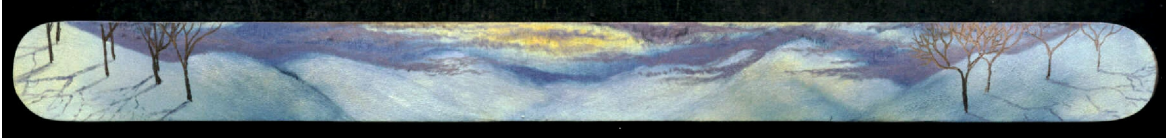

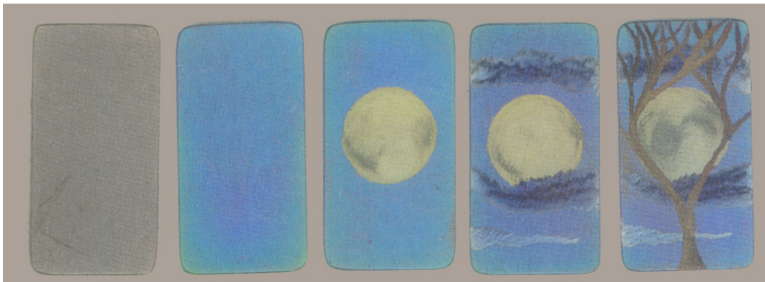
Opportunities with the Tree of Life Collective

Titanium, the primary medium we work with, is a reactive metal and changes color when anodized. We get these intricate designs through sequences of engraving then anodizing, engraving then anodizing.



This art, for the accomplished artisan, yields a great hourly return. Part of this provides us with a liveable income, the rest goes towards projects related to social change, ecological activism, and community organizing.

We sell to artisan galleries and jewelry stores all over the northeastern US, by mail, in person, and via internet.
